Tournament Rules – Please read carefully

EARLY BIRD ENTRY: **November 1, 2026.** **NORMAL ENTRY:** starting **November 2, 2026**, will be accepted up to 1 hour before squad time if lanes are available.

ELIGIBILITY: This singles tournament is open to all Citrus Belt USBC current members in good standing.

ENTRY FEE: EARLY BIRD ENTRY: \$30.00 per person singles event (Lineage \$12.00, Expense \$5.00 and \$13.00 Prize/BVL fund).

NORMAL ENTRY: \$40.00 per person singles event (Lineage \$12.00, Expense \$5.00 and \$23.00 Prize/BVL fund).

Fees are not refundable after definite times have been assigned or if it is discovered that an entrant failed to comply with USBC eligibility requirements. The Tournament manager may refuse to permit any entrant to bowl if it is determined the entry should not have been accepted.

HANDICAP: Handicap shall be 90% of 210.

DIVISIONS: Men, Women, Boys and Girls.

ENTERING AVERAGE: Use the averages in the order given below as applicable to each bowler. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to ensure the submitted average is correct and/or a corrected average is used at the time of competition.

1. Highest average from the **2025-2026** Citrus Belt Winter or Summer season, based on 21 or more games for adults/15 games for youth.
2. Highest Citrus Belt current average of 21 games adult/15 games youth as of closing entry date.
3. If none of the above, bowler will use 210 average.

RULE 319A-3: It shall be each entrant's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her average, whether originally submitted by the entrant, his/her team captain or others. **Failure to use the proper average may result in disqualification of score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in more handicap.**

Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average.

USBC Rule 319-a2, c, d, e do not apply.

MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION: Bowlers are eligible to compete twice if lanes are available.

CHECK-IN: All individuals as well as team captains must report to check in forty-five (45) minutes prior to squad time.

BOWLING ATTIRE: Participants are requested to wear garments in good taste, appropriate for tournament bowling. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. All shirts must have sleeves. No workout clothing, halter tops or short shorts of any kind allowed. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints. If found to be not in appropriate attire or equipment will result in disqualification with no refund.

CA BVL STATE QUALIFIER: A man, woman, boy and girl champion will qualify to the CA Helen Duval Veterans (BVL) State Finals (to be determined per California State Rules). Only one qualifier per category can advance, so in case of a tie, the bowler with the highest game #3 will move on. If game #3 is a tie, the highest game #2 will determine the winner, etc.

ABSENT OR LATE PLAYERS: Any player arriving late shall begin play at the point of game in which tournament is in and shall receive a zero (0) for any missed frames. Absentee scores shall be 0 for the game.

PRIZES/SCHOLARSHIPS: A plaque will be awarded to the man and woman champion. Scholarships will be awarded to a boy and a girl youth champion and will be held with USBC SMART Account # 9233, (800) 514-2695 x3343.

USBC AWARDS: Scores bowled shall qualify for USBC awards as outlined in Chapter VI of the USBC Playing Rules Book.

EQUIPMENT: Once your squad has started, there shall be no altering of the surface of bowling balls, no foreign substance to be used on shoes **and only a clean dry towel can be used**. Participants must be aware of USBC specifications regarding the hardness of bowling ball. **Holes in a ball not for gripping purpose are not allowed. Bowling balls with no thumb hole will have to have CG marked.**

Lanes will be dressed prior to the first squad each day and before the next squad, providing time permits.

DELAY OF GAME: If equipment failure on a pair of lanes would delay the progress of the series, a tournament official can authorize the completion of a game and series on another pair of certified lanes. The interrupted game and series must be resumed from the point of interruption. No practice will be allowed after being moved. USBC Rule 321 will be waived.

USBC RULES: This is a USBC certified tournament and will be governed by USBC rules even if not specified in this entry.

* **Note** – No-one other than tournament bowlers or those working in the tournament are allowed in the bowlers' area. Offensive language, hand gestures, or harassment of other bowlers is not permitted. Unsportsmanlike conduct can result in disqualification.

Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or there from, fire, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Citrus Belt USBC tournament shall cause, to the extent required there by all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
