Entrants who have bowled will be refunded that portion of fees allocated to the prize fund based on the number who participated in each event. Entrants having not bowled will be refunded their entire entry fee.

TOURNAMENT RULES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

ENTRY CLOSING: Entries must be postmarked on or before **March 19, 2026**. Entries must be accompanied by full payment.

ELIGIBILITY: This is a team, doubles, singles and all-events tournament open to all Citrus Belt USBC Youth members that participated in a Citrus Belt USBC certified league during the 2024-2025 or 2023-2024 season. Members will be required to show proof of membership, if asked.

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 per person per event. With Handicap **All-Events \$5.00**. Remit by money order or check made payable to CBUSBC Association. The Tournament Manager may refuse to permit any team or entrant to bowl if it is determined the entry should not have been accepted. Cancellations will be refunded only if cancelled prior to **March 15, 2026**.

SCHEDULING: This will be made under the discretion of the Tournament Manager. Remember requests do not guarantee the time and date. It is your responsibility to check your confirmation letter to verify date and time assigned. If you are unable to bowl on given date and time, you may call to be rescheduled – however, rescheduling will only be done if times are available. If you have a large group, you can call early to reserve a spot – however, entry fees must be paid to guarantee that slot.

TEAM EVENT – Will consist of any combination of four (4) bowlers. All entries must consist of a full roster of 4.

SINGLES AND DOUBLES – If you bowl singles, you must bowl doubles and vice versa.

TOURNAMENT AWARDS – Scholarships will be given for 1 in 6 entries and any fraction thereof in each division.

COMPETITION – Team, Doubles and Singles will consist of 3 games. You may bowl each event one (1) time.

Boys and girls are in separate divisions for singles and all events!

ENTERING AVERAGE: Use the averages in the order given below as applicable to each bowler. It shall be the bowler's responsibility to insure the submitted average is correct and/or a corrected average is used at the time of competition.

1. Highest average from the **2024-2025** Citrus Belt Winter or Summer Season, based on 12 or more games
2. Highest average from the **2023-2024** Citrus Belt Winter or Summer
3. March 1, 2026, consisting of 12 games
4. April 1, 2026, consisting of 12 games
5. If none of the above, bowler will use 225

HANDICAP: Handicap shall be 90% of 225 for singles, 90% of 450 for doubles, and 90% of 900 for team.

USBC Rule 319-a2, c, d, e does not apply.

SUBSTITUTES: Averages will follow the same as all other entrants. Shall take the place in the lineup of the bowler they are replacing. Lineup will not be changed. Once a substitute has been placed, changes will not be made.

CHECK-IN: Will be thirty (30) minutes prior to squad time. If there are known changes to the roster, the youth director or coach should be there 1 ½ hours prior to squad time. To assist in check-in, you may check in as an individual, but everyone must check in prior to going to his or her assigned lanes.

BOWLING ATTIRE: Bowlers must dress in presentable attire: Girls - skirts, shorts, slacks or skorts. Boys - slacks, jeans or shorts. Shorts should be no longer than 4 inches below the knee and no shorter than 4 inches above the knee. No gang attire, or objectionable statements will be allowed, no cut-offs, spandex pants or hats and head gear will be allowed. Dress code will be enforced. **When in doubt, don't.** Tournament Director's discretion applies.

ABSENT OR LATE PLAYERS: Any player arriving late shall begin play at the point of game in which tournament is in and shall receive a zero (0) for any missed frames. Absentee scores shall be 0 for the game. If a bowler is not there for any missed or given frames, a zero (0) will be given for that frame(s).

USBC YOUTH AWARDS: Scores bowled qualify for USBC awards as outlined in Chapter III of the USBC Playing Rules.

EQUIPMENT: Altering any equipment, approaches, (shoe residue), balls, etc, is not allowed. Sanding of bowling balls must be done prior to the start of the tournament and **only a clean dry towel can be used during the tournament**. Offensive language, hand gestures, or harassment of other bowlers is not permitted. Un-sportsman like conduct can result in disqualification.

Holes in a ball not for gripping purpose are not allowed. Bowling balls with no thumb hole will have to have a CG marked. Lanes will be dressed prior to each squad each day, **providing time permits**.

DISQUALIFICATION: Alcoholic beverages may not be consumed. Smoking is not allowed by any youth participating in the tournament. Food and beverages are allowed but must be kept out of the bowler's area.

COACHING: Is permitted by parents or coaches behind the lanes on the concourse. No yelling will be tolerated.

Note: No one other than tournament bowlers or those working the tournament are allowed in the bowlers' area.

USBC RULES: This is a USBC certified tournament and will be governed by USBC rules even if not specified in this entry

PROTESTS: Must be in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours. Tournament official will resolve all disputes on the lanes.
